



Practical Course in Hair Restoration Surgery

Information and Frequently Asked Questions

The Italian Society of Hair Science and Restoration, in collaboration with **Professor Vincenzo Gambino** and the Centro Medico Turati in Milan, has developed a **Practical Course on Hair Restoration Surgery**.

Professor Vincenzo Gambino is recognized as one of the leading experts on Hair Restoration Surgery both nationally and internationally.

THE COURSE

The course consists of **one or two weeks** of training in which the Doctor and/or assistant will be able to **enter the operating theatre with Professor Gambino** and **observe** the surgical operations taking place, to learn **F.U.T.** and **F.U.E.** techniques.

Professor Gambino performs **between 6 to 10 operations** during the week (Monday to Friday, from 8:00am to 6:00pm), which the participant will be able to observe.

Participants will reserve a set week to attend the course. The course is individual, with the chosen week blocked **exclusively** for the participant, allowing that Professor Gambino to provide **1:1 teaching** throughout.

The course is also open to **surgical assistants**, and surgeons can book to attend together with their assistants if they wish.

LOCATION

The course is held across two locations in Milan, Italy:

- **Turati Medical Centre** (Piazza Cavour 1, Milan, 20121)
- **San Raffaele Hospital** (Via Olgettina 60, Milan, 20132)

DATES

Courses are scheduled in **one-week blocks** (Monday-Friday, 07:30-18:00), during a week selected by the participant in line with Professor Gambino's schedule availability.

WHAT IS INCLUDED

Lunch is provided during the day. Participants must bring their own clothes, shoes and surgical mask for the operating theatre.

At the end of the course, a **Certificate of Participation** from the Italian Society of Hair Science and Restoration will be presented.


HOW TO ENROL

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I find out the dates for my course?

Training courses are allocated in one-week blocks. If you wish to participate in two weeks of training these can be consecutive or can be split across two separate occasions.

Once you have completed the online module, we will contact you to arrange a date. You can advise us of your preferred time frames, and we will confirm a week based on Professor Gambino's schedule.

Will the course be in English?

Professor Gambino speaks both Italian and English

I want to observe only a particular technique (e.g. FUE or FUT). Can this be arranged?

No. Both FUT and FUE techniques will be covered during the week. However, techniques utilized in each case are determined based on the needs of each individual patient, and therefore we cannot guarantee a minimum observation of either type of technique.

How many operations will I be able to observe during the course?

Professor Gambino usually performs two procedures per day, however this is dependent on scheduling and individual needs of each client. Participants will be able to observe between 6-10 procedures during a one-week course.

What do I need to bring to the course?

Participants are required to provide their own clothes and shoes to wear into the operating room (scrubs), as well as surgical mask.

Lunch is provided on the day however we recommend participants bring any other snacks or refreshments they may wish to have.

Will there be other participants on the course?

No. This course is individual and once the dates for your course are confirmed and payment has been received, the dates are reserved exclusively for you. Professor Gambino will provide direct 1:1 teaching during the procedures in the operating room.

However, the option is available for surgeons and surgical assistants to attend together if they wish.

Can surgical assistants attend the course without a surgeon?

No.

More about Professor Vincenzo Gambino

Professor Gambino graduated from the University of Pavia in Medicine and Surgery, and in 1990 specialized in the surgical treatment of hair restoration at the Elliot-Thomas Medical Group in New York. He is currently a Professor of the Masters of Hair Sciences degree in the Department of Medicine at the University of Florence, and is a past President of International Society of Hair Restoration Surgery (I.S.H.R.S).

Professor Vincenzo Gambino's innovative techniques are capable of resolving many different hair loss issues. His expertise in the auto-transplantation of follicular units allows for a very natural result, without any visible scarring. One of the most important aspects of Professor Gambino's skill is that thanks to his experience and dexterity, he is able to insert the follicular units in the receiving section with the correct inclination, following the natural growth of the hair. This allows for visual balance between the implanted areas of the scalp and those preexisting.
