HOW TO GET THERE

FROM FLORENCE PERETOLA AIRPORT

Taxi: The journey will take around 25 minutes and will likely cost around €30.

Public Transport:

- Take the T-2 tram from Florence Airport 12 stops to Piazza dell'Unità Italiana (the stop is called 'Unità'). The stop is right next to Florence's main train station, which is called Santa Maria Novella.
- Then, take the number 7 bus from the 'Piazza Adua' bus stop opposite the train station (**fig. 1**). The journey takes approximately 18 minutes (**fig. 2**).
 - Get off at stop 'San Domenico 07'.
- Cross to the other side of the road at the pedestrian crossing, and walk up the hill towards Via Iacopone (**fig. 3**).
 - Turn left at Via Iacopone, and walk up the hill. Villa la Stella will be on your right.

FROM FLORENCE CENTRAL TRAIN STATION - SANTA MARIA NOVELLA

- Take the number 7 bus from the 'Piazza Adua' bus stop opposite the train station (**fig. 1**). The journey takes approximately 18 minutes (**fig. 2**).
 - Get off at stop 'San Domenico 07'.
- Cross to the other side of the road at the pedestrian crossing, and walk up the hill towards Via Iacopone (**fig. 3**).
 - Turn left at Via Iacopone, and walk up the hill. Villa la Stella will be on your right.
